



Important Information about Helicopter Flight Activity in Your Neighborhood

Dear Neighbor,

During these unprecedented times, Southern California Edison (SCE) is focused as ever on safely providing reliable service to our communities. Barnard Construction Company, a SCE contractor, is working in your neighborhood to build the West of Devers (WOD) Upgrade Project. This project will provide additional capacity necessary to bring renewable and conventional generation being developed in desert areas in eastern Riverside County. These significant upgrades will enhance electric reliability for all customers and help to make the power grid greener for California.

Activities in your area:

Helicopters will be used to upgrade facilities in the SCE project right-of-way from *west of Pennsylvania Avenue to Interstate 10 in Beaumont*.

What to Expect

- **If you have received this notice, Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulations require that you keep clear of your yard while the helicopter is operating in the area. Please remain indoors while work is under way.**
- During construction, there may be traffic lane and sidewalk closures. You may see trucks and cranes on the streets near you, and the streets may be closed while the helicopter is in flight. SCE will use a combination of traffic control signs and crew members with flags to ensure vehicle and pedestrian safety.

- **Hours: 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.**

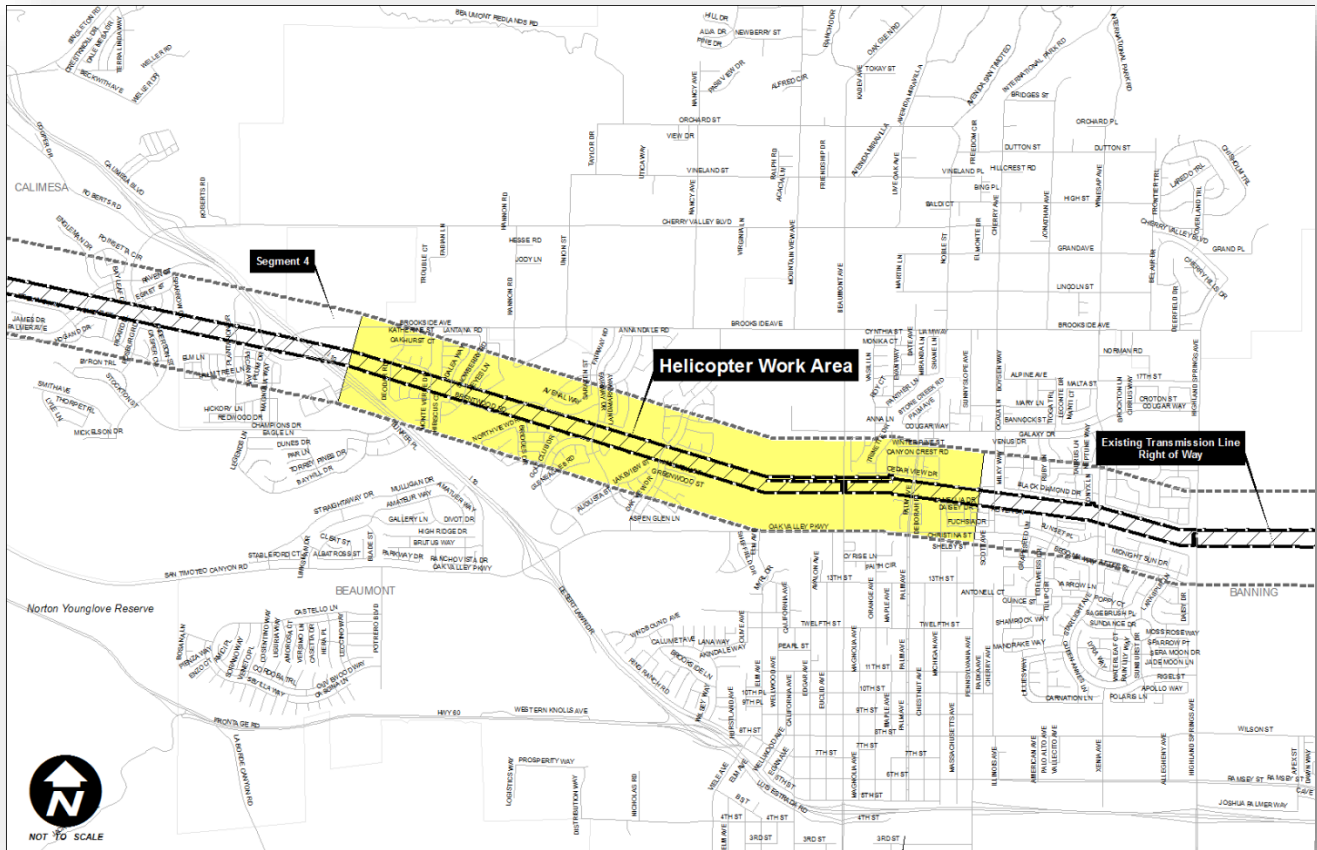
