Common Area Landscape Advisory Committee (CALAC)

The purpose and scope of the Common Area Landscaping Advisory Committee (CALAC) is to advise and make recommendations to the Board of Directors on (1) landscape design and (2) evaluation of common area maintenance.

DESIGN REVIEW COMMITTEE (DRC)

The purpose and scope of the Design Review Committee (DRC) is to review all lot landscape plans, requests for new construction or alterations of the existing structures.

FINANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE (FAC)

The purpose and scope of the Finance Advisory Committee (FAC) is to have general control of the financial policy of the Association, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors, including ways and means for obtaining funds necessary to meet the authorized budget for carrying out the work of the Association. The General Manager will provide the applicable financial information to the Committee.

NEW RESIDENT WELCOME COMMITTEE (NRWC)

The purpose and scope of the New Resident Welcome Advisory Committee (NRWC) is to welcome new residents into the community and provide them with useful information that will make their transition into Solera Oak Valley Greens Association a pleasant experience. This Committee will provide information about Solera and surrounding areas.

RECREATION ACTIVITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE (RAAC)

The purpose and scope of the Recreation Activities Advisory Committee (RAAC) is to advise and make recommendations to the Board of Directors related to social and recreational activities for the community, and to plan and execute all Board approved RAAC activities.

EMERGENCY READINESS ADVISORY COMMITTEE (ERAC)
